Currently reads:

Basketball Backboards: (Not applicable to Condominiums)

- (a) Basketball backboards are permitted under the following conditions:
  - (1.) Backboards only affixed to the Dwelling – No Standards.
  - (2.) Backboards must be permanently bolted to the front of the Dwelling, Immediately adjacent to the driveway. Any variation from such placement of the backboard shall require the prior written approval of the Architectural Committee.
  - (3.) Backboards must be fan-shaped and stained to match trim on the Respective Dwelling.
  - (4.) Backboards must be kept in good condition and re-stained as necessary.

Pg. 8, Item No 15. With approved changes will read:

**Basketball Backboards.** (Not applicable to Condominiums)

- (a) ***Basketball backboards*** are permitted under the following conditions:
  - (1.) Backboards only affixed to the Dwelling.
  - (2.) Backboards must be permanently bolted to the front of the Dwelling, Immediately adjacent to the driveway. Any variation from such placement of the backboard shall require the prior written approval of the Architectural Committee.
  - (3.) Backboards must be fan-shaped and stained to match trim on the respective Dwelling.
  - (4.) Backboards must be kept in good condition and re-stained as necessary.
  
- (b) ***Portable basketball hoops and standards*** are permitted under the following conditions:
  - (1.) Basketball hoops and standards may not be stored on the sidewalks, driveway aprons or streets within the community.
  - (2.) Basketball hoops & standards must be stored on the owner's property.
  - (3.) Basketball hoops and standards must be maintained in a clean, safe and attractive condition at all times.
  
- (c) ***Permanent basketball hoop and standards*** are permitted under the following conditions:
  - (1.) Prior written architectural approval is obtained from Architectural Committee.
  - (2.) Homeowner obtains written approval from neighboring lots.
  - (3.) Basketball hoops and standards must be maintained in a clean, safe and attractive condition at all times.
